Tentative budget for the next school year was approved. It is basically the same as the current year budget as no increases were approved by the General Assembly for schools and is slightly over 5 million dollars. Salary schedules were approved with slight increases including \$100 per cell on certified and 50 cents an hour to classified (hourly employees). Bond of Depository was approved along with reducing services from WKEC dropping Innovations in Education. Change order 7 was approved for the building project to extend sidewalks and walkways and BG 4 to close out the gym roof project were approved. Annual audit will be performed by Williams, Williams & Lentz. As new federal require the increase costs of meal prices, lunch prices were increased from \$1 to \$1.05

A look back at the May 5, 1961 meeting of the Carlisle County School Board: Wallace Duane Webb, CCHS English teacher and coach of speech and dramatics, requested financial assistance with costs of the speech and dramatics participations. The school calendar was amended to make-up snow days with the last day to be May 24. Teachers were hired for the next school year the electric bill for the Cunningham School was \$35.44.
