

Board meeting summary

A moment of silence was held in memory of Logan Simpson. Brooke Kelley presented a shared job time proposal the board approved.

Construction update is the first round of bids are expected on June 21st. These bids cover the site development for the cafeteria and re-roofing the high school gym. Site development work is expected to take 45 days. New traffic patterns and temporary loading/unloading plans will be released later this summer.

The first reading of the proposed school board policies as presented by the KSBA policy service was read. The BG-2 for the cafeteria project was approved. The student handbook for 2011-12 was approved and is available for viewing on the district website. The board approved an extension to the school energy management grant offered by the KSBA. The board approved paying all bills received bills received through June 30 for this fiscal year. The superintendent's annual evaluation was conducted. Approval was given for FFA to attend camp in Hardinsburg, July 11-15. A BG1 was approved for permission to proceed with performance contracting project to improve energy efficiency of lights including upgrading lighting in the middle and school gyms.

A look back at the June 7, 1960 meeting of the Carlisle County School Board: the board approved advertising for the 3 room and 2 room classroom frame buildings at the Cunningham School. The 3 room building was sold on June 24th to Fred Pickett for \$600 and the 2 room building to Earl Summers for \$801 with the stipulation they clean up the site after moving the buildings.
