

Carlisle County Energy Management Team Meeting

September 20, 2011

Minutes

The Carlisle County District Energy Management Team met Tuesday, September 20, 2011, 9:00 AM in the Gold Room. Twelve of the eighteen members were present. The major item on the agenda was review and approval of a district energy management plan to be sent to the school board. The plan approved has four major components: Education, Waste Reduction, Retrofit Projects, and Monitoring and Assisting. Necessary corrections to the copy will be made, the plan reviewed by team members and then forwarded to the superintendent.

School energy teams were discussed. An effort is being made by building administrators to get teams in place. This will afford each school to take advantage of several programs available through KGHS, NEED, KEEPS and Energy Star. School teams are strongly encouraged, if not required to participate in some programs offered. It was noted that Mr. Steven Queen is sponsoring the high school energy team. Elementary and Middle schools are still trying to get sponsors on board.

Ms. Margaret Wilson informed the group that she is working on installation of equipment which will shut down computers appropriately throughout the district. She currently has the high school business lab on the program. This initiative should result in significant usage reduction for the district, not to mention the dollar reduction in electricity.

Energy Awareness Month, October, was discussed. The Energy Guys will be at the Middle School for a presentation on October 11, 1:30 PM. These shows are entertaining and educational or students and faculty alike. An energy conservation display is being developed by Lisa Adams and Jim Crouse to be set up in conjunction with Parent/Teacher conferences on October 18, 3-6 PM. Energy Conservation programs, contests, and the like are encouraged during October.
