- Drivers and principals will be contacted first and by no later than 5:45 a.m.
- The media will be contacted by approximately 6:00 a.m., specifically TV Channels 6 and 12, Radio stations, 93.3, 95.9 and 96.9.
- When the weather is questionable, buses may be a few minutes early for pick-up as well as somewhat later with deliveries.
- If you have signed up for e-communication on the district website, you will receive a text message and/or email concerning school closings.
- The Carlisle County webpage will also post on the opening page.
- Should roads become impassable or too dangerous for buses to travel, alternative pick-ups and deliveries may be arranged through the driver and/or office staff.
- Our drivers are committed to the safety of your child. We will use our best judgment in making weather-related decisions. Under no circumstances will the safety and well-being of our students be compromised.
- You are encouraged to be patient as we work through the winter months together. Your cooperation and understanding will do much to enhance our effort to safely operate our schools.
